The interior ceiling finish is white stucco galvanized, which—along with the LED light fixtures—ensures maximum illumination is provided. The 34" x 76" entrance door is equipped with a thermostatically controlled door and frame heater, vapor proof light, 1/8" aluminum kickplates 36" high on the interior and exterior to protect the door against excessive abuse

and traffic, and vinyl strip curtains.
