

With Thermo-Kool's ability to manufacture in 1" panel increments the walk-in was manufactured in the exact size and configuration needed to maximize storage space capabilities with no "cutting and pasting" required in the field! The White Stucco Aluminum finish provided on the interior along with LED light fixtures ensures maximum illumination is provided. The entrance doors are equipped with 14" x 14" peep windows with heated frame and glass, adjustable hinges, vinyl swing doors, and each compartment includes a Thermo-Kool TK4700 Walk-In Monitor System which features multi-compartment temperature monitoring, high and low temperature alarm, door status monitoring, automatic lighting control, compartment

identification, door/door frame/peep window heater control, motion detectors, door open alarm and a panic alarm.




