

Cars roam the heated pavement, traveling back and forth from job to home while kids litter the sidewalk, fresh out of school and looking for the kind of fun only summer can bring. And on the corner of this normal, routine scene, where Market Street and Midlothian meet, is a gas station. Inside, tucked safely away from the heat, is "Handel's Frozen Custard."



Alice Handel, wife of the gas station owner, made herself a name that summer for creating delicious, homemade ice cream with fresh fruit straight from her backyard garden. Word spread fast of the sweet treat that was just too good to pass up. Soon the cars that once drove by the gas station

were lining up to enjoy the soon-to-be legendary "Handel's Homemade Ice Cream & Yogurt."

78 years later and the name Handel is still a huge presence in the ice cream arena. To date, they have grown to include additional company owned and franchised stores in six states, spanning from California to Virigina.





Needless to say, Handel's doesn't skimp on quality, so when it came to purchasing walk-ins for their business, they needed a company with a history of quality to match their own. **Thermo-Kool's** 63 years in the industry and their reputation for quality and service was a natural choice. The first walk-in cooler Thermo-Kool built for Handel's was for their Berwyn, Pennsylvania location. The walk-in was custom-made to fit the building's unique specifications and was assembled at Thermo-Kool's factory location before shipment to guarantee no installation issues or cutting and pasting at the jobsite. The floorless unit was built with an internal and external stucco aluminum finish. The entrance door, 36" X 78", is equipped with a pilot light and switch assembly, vapor-proof light, dial thermometer, and vinyl strip curtains.

Thermo-Kool Customer Account Representative, **Allison Ishee**, worked on the project with **Anne Tropf** and **Lon Paglio** with Paglio & Associates. The drafter working on the project was **Jacob Ledet**.

And what's more exciting than ice cream? More ice cream! Handel's will be opening their newest store in Hendersonville, Tennessee just in time to sooth the heat of the summer. So, if you find yourself in town, driving along the heated pavement to wherever it is you're going. Be sure to notice the shop on the corner. You may just find the sweetest legacy.

CHILI COOK OFF


